

#### **The South-South Cooperation Program: « Initiatives Climat Afrique Francophone » (ICAF)** was launched in 2016 on the occasion of the COP22. Two associations (Initiatives Climat Morocco and Initiatives Climat France) are implementing this Program.



## **Objectives**

- Contribute to awareness of the effects of climate change

- Increase capacity of project holders who act to mitigate the effects of climate change and to adapt to these modifications



## **Key topics**

- Green energies: solar, green charcoal, biogas
   Agroecology: peasant seeds, organic inputs, sustainable soil management
- Green entrepreneurship



#### Activities

- An online database identifies 300 positive initiatives to fight the negative effects of climate change.

- Young green entrepreneurs participating in the transition to a green economy are supported.

- During Research & Development workshops, some prototypes are built : green charcoal production equipment, granaries for peasant seeds.



Collaborative trainings bring participants from all over Africa to exchange experiences.
Ten trainings have been organized: in Benin, Burkina Faso, Ivory Coast, Morocco, Senegal, Togo.

- Members of two clusters: the African Green Charcoal Cluster and the African Agroecology Cluster

## **Events**

Each year, the ICAF Trophies reward the most exemplary "climate initiatives".

### Conferences and workshops are

organized at some international events such as the COP on the climate change.

Some Forums "Youth and Green Entrepreneurship in Africa" includes participants from a dozen countries. They allow young green entrepreneurs to share their experiences and discuss the opportunities and constraints of green entrepreneurship.
